ComSoc Best Paper Awards



Purpose

The Polish Chapter of IEEE Communications Society has established ComSoc Best Paper Awards during "Konferencja Radiokomunikacji i Teleinformatyki" KRiT 2023, one for each of the following areas

a) the best paper among all the conference participants

b) the best paper with at least one coauthor being a member of the Polish IEEE Communications Society (ComSoc Best Paper Award for ComSoc member).

The purpose of the ComSoc Best Paper Awards is twofold:

- To acknowledge and promote outstanding achievements in the communications field;
- To promote the Polish Chapter of Communications Society in the academia and industry community.

Rules & Eligibility

In order to be eligible for any of the two ComSoc Best Paper Awards, the candidate paper must be submitted, reviewed, and accepted for KRiT 2023 conference.

During the registration for the conference, at least one of the paper authors must apply for the Award (by using the KRiT 2023 submission system).

<u>ComSoc Best Paper Award for ComSoc member requires at least one of the paper authors</u> to be the IEEE ComSoc member (provisioning of the IEEE member number is required)

For each award, one paper will be selected based on the highest mean score after reviews out of all papers eligible for a given award. The selection will be carried out by the KRiT 2023 organizers and the required information will be passed to the Award committee (paper title, authors, IEEE member number if needed). By applying for the award authors agree to such an information exchange.

If the above procedure does not allow to find a single paper winning each Award, e.g., there are no papers eligible or there are a few of the same, maximal mean score, the Awards Committee decides on the solution to be applied.

Each award must be received by at least one of its winners in person at KRiT 2023. No award will be made in absentia, except under extraordinary circumstances, as determined by the Awards Committee.

Both awards are independent in the sense that authors can apply for a single or both Awards, if the eligibility criteria are met.

Application Procedure

- During conference participant registration for KRiT 2023 candidates can apply for ComSoc Best Paper Award or ComSoc Best Paper Award for ComSoc member in the submission system.
- When applying for ComSoc Best Paper Award for ComSoc Member, candidates will be asked to provide their IEEE member identification number for at least one coauthor being IEEE Communications Society member.

Results and Awards

The ComSoc Best Paper Award recipients will be announced and granted during the KRiT 2023 conference.

The winner(s) of each Award obtain a single award certificate and 1900 zł to be divided between authors.

In the case of a co-authored awarded paper, the winners can declare to the Awards Committee, after being awarded, how they divide the financial award among authors. In the absence of such a declaration, the amount will be equally split among authors.

The awarded authors that are eligible for the financial prize are required to provide their details to the Award Committee, i.e., Name, address, PESEL, and bank account number, after obtaining the award certificate.

If these details are not provided the financial prize will be not granted.
